The tuition for the Skills Based Driver Engineering Program may be paid by check, money order, cash (exact amount), Discover, Visa or MasterCard. An installment plan is also available through credit card purchases for an additional one time \$10.00 or \$30.00 processing fee, depending on the payment plan.

MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT FOR THE AUTOMOBILE SAFETY INSPECTION IMMEDIATELY! This inspection can be performed by any licensed repair facility. Not required for new (under 15,000 miles) or rental vehicles.

Unacceptable Training Vehicles

Some vehicles may be unacceptable for training purposes. Other vehicles may have limitations that will not allow for maximum training levels.

In order to assure that the student receives the maximum benefit, we strongly recommend that you discuss the selection of the vehicle to be used in the driving skills exercises with a member of our staff prior to the clinic.

For your convenience a Personal/Auto Checklist and General Information sheet is on the next page. Please review this prior to class.

Please do not reschedule at the last minute. If you must reschedule, please give us at least five days notification. Clinic slots that can not be replaced result in higher costs and delays in training. **A rescheduling fee of 50% (one half), of the Two-Day Skills tuition will be charged unless the student notifies MasterDrive no less than 5 (five) business days prior to the confirmed class. If the student 'NO SHOWS' without prior notification to MasterDrive, the rescheduling fee is 100% of the Two Day Skills tuition.** There will be a rescheduling fee of \$50.00 for any cancellation of an appointment for any classroom session or on-street training unless student notifies MasterDrive at least 48 hours in advance of that lesson.

We request that students driving standard transmission cars be reasonably comfortable with basic clutch operation before participating in the Two-Day Skills Clinic. One hour of individual off-street private instruction with one of our staff, using the student's car, is available at an additional \$60.00 fee.

We have found that the most effective training is realized when two consecutive days of skills training are followed by the classroom sessions. This gives the student the experience which helps them understand and relate to the classroom material.

Rarely do we cancel a clinic, but if we do, please bear with us. We will reschedule as soon as possible. A message will be left on our voice mail by 7:15 a.m. the day of the clinic notifying you of cancellation or delay.

PERSONAL / AUTO CHECKLIST AND GENERAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL AND PICK UP:

- ✓ All training times are sent with the confirmation letter. We require that you arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of class.

We encourage parents to attend the “recital” held during the last hour (usually 4:00-5:00pm) on the second day of the skills clinic. This will give the parents the opportunity to observe their teen’s newly acquired skills and to ride with the new driver through the exercises (parents and teens willing) an experience both parents and teens should not miss!

DRIVER PREPARATION:

- ✓ Tennis shoes or any flat soled shoes. Thick soled shoes/boots are strongly discouraged.
“Flip-Flops” or loose fitting sandals are a safety hazard and are not allowed!
- ✓ Weather resistant jacket/coat.
- ✓ Sunglasses, sunscreen, hat.
- ✓ Snacks and/or lunch with beverages.
- ✓ Please leave all personal items at home. MasterDrive is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
i.e. (cell phones, iPods, etc..)

During the Two Day Skills Clinic and Classroom sessions there are no food or refreshment facilities readily available. Please bring a "Brown Bag" lunch, to include several beverages each day.

CAR PREPARATION:

- ✓ Check fluid levels (oil, coolant, transmission).
- ✓ Check tires (air pressure, visible tread).
- ✓ Check wheels (covers secure, lug nuts snug).
- ✓ Check brake pads - brake fluid level.
- ✓ Check for firm brake pedal, brake lights operational.
- ✓ Seat belts (YOU MUST WEAR THEM).
- ✓ Any loose or hazardous objects removed from interior and cargo area.
- ✓ Gas tank at least 3/4 full.
- ✓ Battery adequately secured.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- ✓ Brakes should be bled and fluid changed annually.
- ✓ Car should be in proper alignment.
- ✓ Manufacturer tire pressure recommendation should be noted.

YOU SHOULD ADD 4 TO 5 LB. ABOVE RECOMMENDED PRESSURE PER TIRE SPECIFICALLY DURING CLASS. YOU WILL BE PUTTING THE CAR INTO SOME STRESS, AND THEREFORE THERE WILL BE SOME LIMITED WEAR ON THE TIRES.

Safety is always our first priority - An unsafe vehicle may be removed from the clinic.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

The undersigned hereby acknowledges his or her understanding that there are risks inherent in the process of learning to drive, and in driving a vehicle, and that while MasterDrive has taken and will take every precaution to minimize such risks and to maximize the safety of MasterDrive students, trainees and participants, some risks understandably remain, and cannot be controlled by MasterDrive or its teachers, coaches, employees and agents.

In consideration of the above, and of the undersigned participant's ("Participant") attendance at and/or participation in a MasterDrive training program, Participant hereby agrees as follows:

1. I hereby knowingly and voluntarily waive forever any and all liability on the part of, and covenant not to sue or institute any claim against MasterDrive, its agents, instructors, insurers, lessors, successors, or assigns, or of any sponsor (collectively "MasterDrive"), resulting from or arising out of or in connection with my attendance at and/or participation in a MasterDrive training program. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless MasterDrive from any and all claims, demands or causes of action, which allege negligent acts or omissions of MasterDrive, unless such negligent acts or omissions are found by a court of law to constitute willful, wanton or gross negligence.

2. I warrant and represent that I personally, and my vehicle, are fully insured and will at all times during the period of my participation in the MasterDrive training program continue to be fully insured in accordance with applicable state law; and in addition, that I have both personal liability and property damage coverage deemed by me sufficient and adequate to cover any exposure to me, my vehicle, or the property or person of others, arising from participation in the MasterDrive program.

3. I acknowledge that the development of driving skills entails known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical and/or emotional injury to myself and/or third parties, and damage to my property and/or the property of others. I understand that while every effort is made to reduce them, such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential elements of this type of driving skills training.

4. I acknowledge that I must accept and assume all of the risks of my individual actions and responsibilities, and those existing in this type of training activity. I therefore accept and assume full responsibility for my actions during all MasterDrive training, and during such time periods and locations which are within the scope of such training (including but not limited to classrooms, parking lots, etc.). It is understood that MasterDrive will not accept responsibility for the actions and/or mistakes of any participant. Participant's attendance is voluntary, and he or she elects to participate in spite of the inherent risks explained above.

5. Should MasterDrive or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, Participant agrees to indemnify them for all such fees and costs.

6. By signing this document, I acknowledge that if I am injured or if my property is damaged during my participation in this training, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against MasterDrive, its agents, instructors, insurers, sponsors, employees, successors and assigns.

DRIVER ENGINEERING CONTRACT

Agreement made this (day) _____ of (month) _____, of (year) _____

between MasterDrive and _____ in consideration of the tuition fee described below:
(Parent or Guardian if Student is under age 18)

The Skills Based Driver Engineering Course is presented as a total package for a current fixed tuition. Each of the three phases are designed to achieve specific goals, with an eventual objective which is to accomplish a young driver who has a higher level of car control skills as well as a level of proficiency of driving on the street in specific situations.

THE MASTERDRIVE GUARANTEE

MasterDrive's primary focus is on producing the best new driver possible, but it is understood that there is no such thing as a 'perfect' driver. If in the professional opinion of a MasterDrive coach, additional coaching is warranted MasterDrive will provide up to double the program hours in any phase of the Driver Engineering Course at no additional cost to the student. The additional training will be developed by MasterDrive upon review of the individual circumstances and in coordination with the student's parents or guardian, or student if older than 18 years of age. In addition;

IF the parents have attended the Recital Briefing and Ride-Through at the completion of the Teen Survival Skills clinic, and; IF the parents do not feel that they have received value for the tuition, the parents may come to the MasterDrive office within three days of completing the two day Teen Survival Skills clinic and before participating in any additional training with MasterDrive and request a full refund. All tuition will be refunded to the parents. It is understood that there is a specific condition of the parents attending the parent briefing and riding through with their child in the recital. IF, however, the student has not been allowed to complete the course due to unsafe driving and not abiding by the instructions of the coaches, this guarantee is automatically cancelled and of no further effect.

In addition, all parties agree and understand that every student is different and in some cases individual students cannot safely or successfully complete the three phases of the Driver Engineering Course without intervention and additional support. In the event MasterDrive determines a student requires specific accommodation and additional support outside the scope of the standard Driver Engineering Course in order to safely and successfully complete or attempt to complete the Driver Engineering Course, MasterDrive agrees to provide an initial one-hour Strategy Session at no cost to determine the steps needed to prepare the student for completion of the Driver Engineering Course. Any additional support or training required to prepare the student for the completion of the Driver Engineering Course beyond this initial Strategy Session will be charged on an hourly basis in addition to the Driver Engineering Course fee until such time that the student is deemed able to safely complete the Driver Engineering Course.

It is understood that MasterDrive will not refund any tuition, or portion of tuition, if a student and/or family have not lived up to the conditions of the agreement, nor when a student arbitrarily decides to withdraw from the program. Payment is required in full, accompanying the application, unless other arrangements in regard to partial payments have been made. It is understood that if an agreement with partial payments has been made, the student and/or family are obligated to complete such payments as agreed.

Short notice cancellations or no shows for any portion of the program involve specific expenses for MasterDrive, which are necessary in order to schedule all training programs. Therefore MasterDrive asks for cooperation in making and keeping all appointments. The student and/or parents understands that there will be a rescheduling fee of \$50.00 for any cancellation of an appointment for any classroom session or on-street training unless student notifies MasterDrive at least 48 hours in advance of that lesson. A rescheduling fee of the fifty percent (50%) of the Two Day Skills tuition will be charged unless the student notifies MasterDrive no less than five (5) business days prior to the confirmed clinic. IF THE STUDENT DOES NOT NOTIFY MASTERDRIVE AT ALL, THE RESCHEDULING FEE IS ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE TUITION.

It is the responsibility of the student and/or parents to provide a vehicle for the Two-Day Teen Survival Skills clinic. It is understood that the vehicle provided will have liability insurance coverage, and that a certificate of insurance must be provided to MasterDrive at least 5 days before the clinic. It is also understood that the vehicle must pass a safety inspection demonstrating that the basic operating systems of the vehicle are in working order. MasterDrive will furnish a dual control vehicle for the on-street portion of the training. MasterDrive reserves the right to reschedule an appointment in the event of inclement weather, mechanical breakdown, illness or termination of a coach, or for any other factors beyond its control.

This contract is effective for a period of twelve (12) months from the above date, after which all obligations shall be deemed to have been provided.

This agreement constitutes the entire Contract between MasterDrive and any student, and no verbal assurances or promises not contained herein shall bind MasterDrive in any way. The undersigned student or parent/guardian certifies that they have read and understood the Contract.
